- Anzac Day is a special day for NZ and Australia.

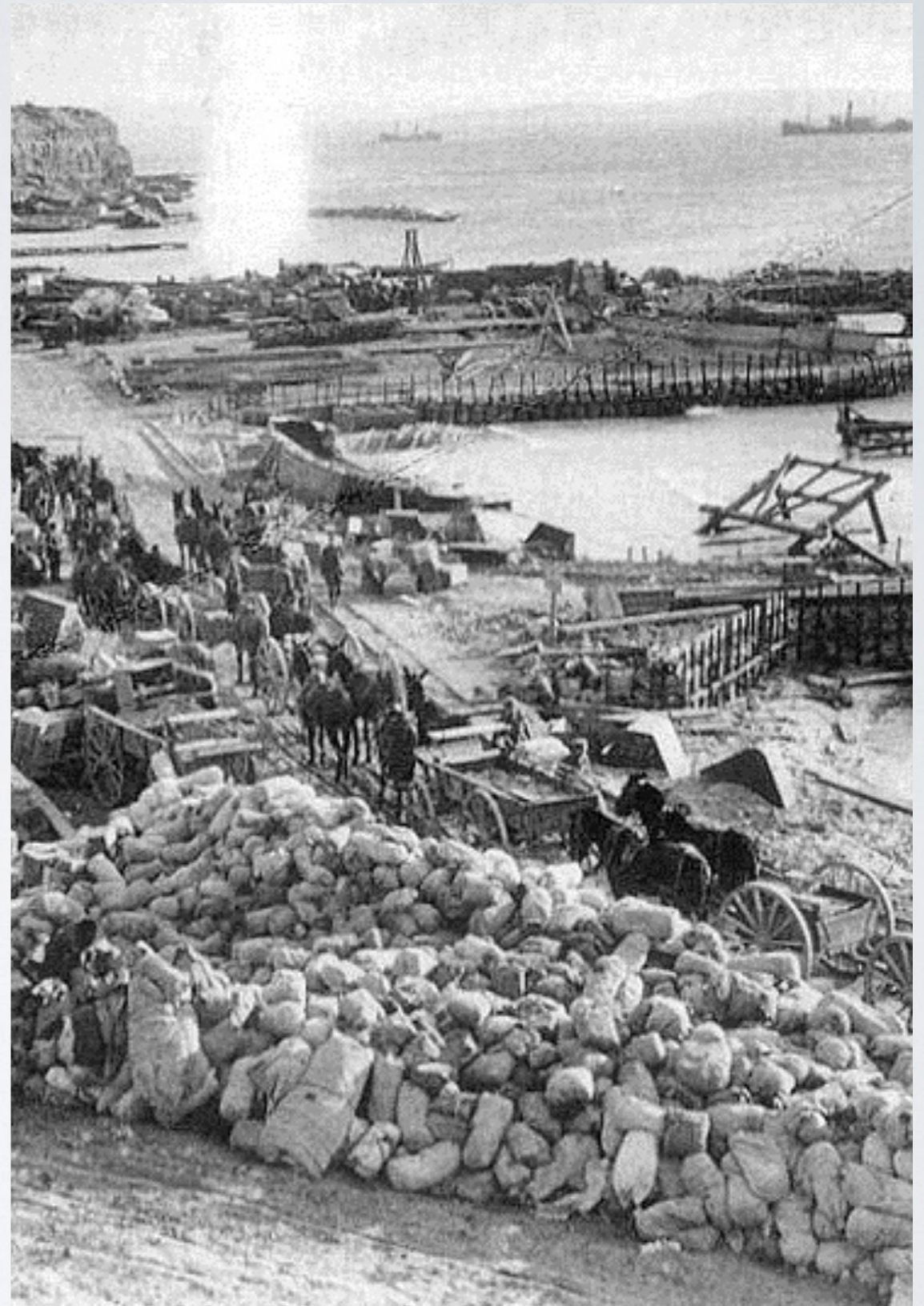


Anzac Day is on 25th of April each year because this is the day when the Australian and New Zealand soldiers landed on the beach in Gallipoli.

Anzac Day started to remember the soldiers who died at Gallipoli. Over 10,000 New Zealand and Australian soldiers died in Gallipoli.

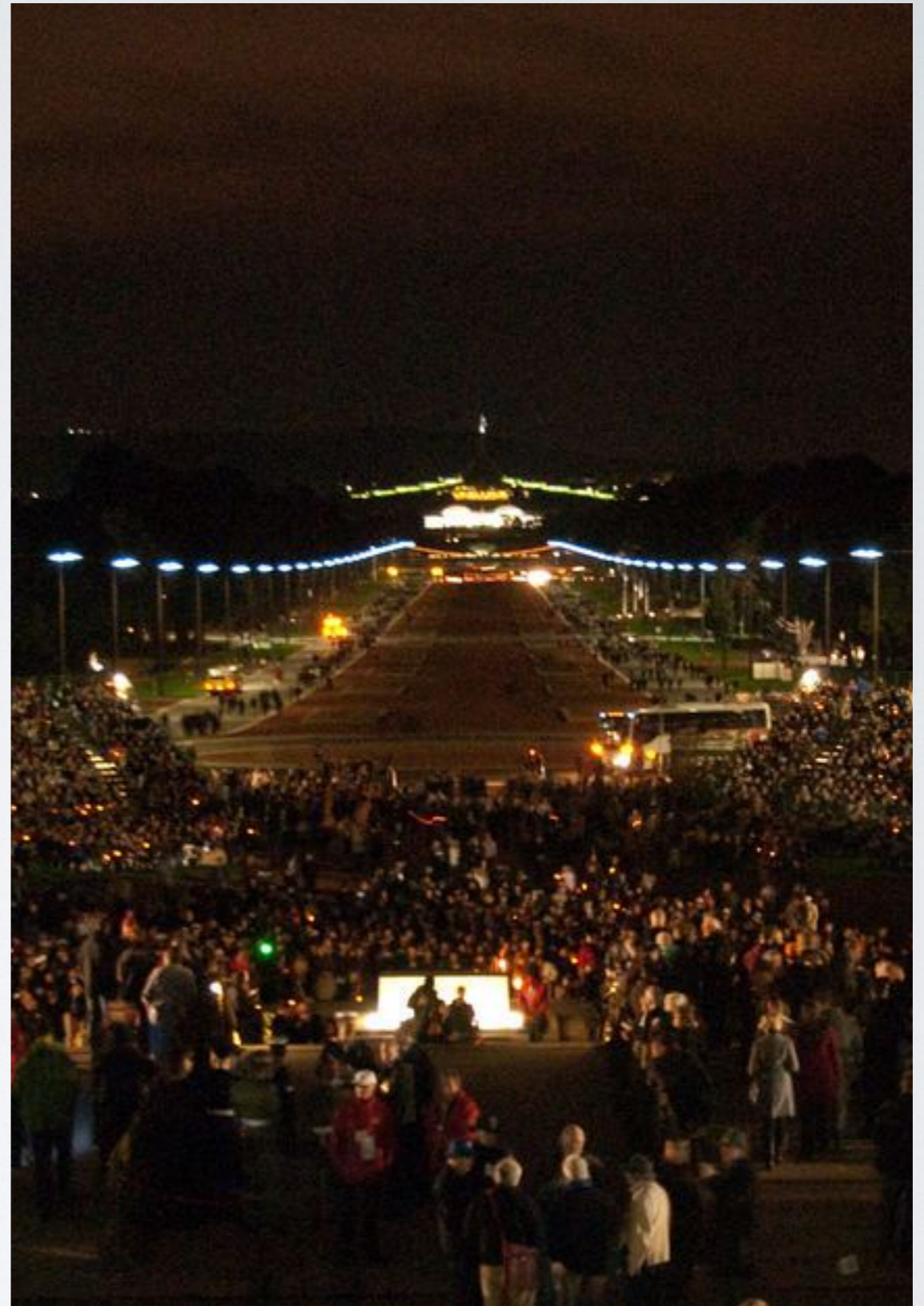


Anzac Day is to remember the NZ and Australian soldiers who died in wars, but also those who are still fighting in wars around the world.
